## **Pool Rules**

The Cross Oak Pool is a private pool that is for use by residents and their guests only.

Pool hours 10:00 am - 10:00 pm

In the case of an emergency, call 911 using one of the phones available for emergency calls. The address': 9009 Cross
Oak Ranch Blvd., Cross Roads, TX 76227 for the large pool or
8711 Trailblazer, Cross Roads, TX 76277 for the small pool.

- 1. The pool is for Cross Oak Ranch Homeowners Association residents who are current on dues.
- 2. A maximum of two guests are allowed with residents.
- 3. Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult.
- 4. Incontinent individuals must wear snug fitting plastic pants or water-resistant diapers. Children that are not potty trained must wear swim diapers.
- 5. Any person who has diarrhea, an infection or contagious disease that may be transmitted through water, an open cut, blister, wounds, or lesion may not enter the pool.
- 6. Any person suspected of being under the influence of alcohol or drugs shall be prohibited from entering the pool.
- 7. No animals or pets allowed in the pool area except service dogs.
- 8. Food and drink must be kept away from the pool area.
- 9. Residents should shower before entering the pool.
- 10. No glass or breakable objects are permitted in the poll area.
- 11. No smoking or alcohol allowed in or around the pool area.
- 12. No loud or excessive noise in the pool area. Foul language will not be tolerated.
- 13. Spitting, spouting water, blowing the nose, urinating or defecating in the pool is prohibited.
- 14. There should be no running, pushing, diving dunking, dangerous horseplay or other inappropriate behavior in the pool area.
- 15. No bicycles, skateboards, etc. allowed inside the pool gates.
- 16. The pool gate should not be propped or left open at any time.
- 17. Flotation devices allowed during non-crowded conditions and at the managers/life-guards discretion.
- 18. Parents and guardians should supervise their children.

The Homeowners Association reserves the right to deny pool usage to anyone at any time for breaking pool/neighborhood rules or causing pool vandalism. During regular business hours (8:30 am-5 pm Monday thru Friday) please report pool problems to Spectrum Association Management at (972) 992-3444. For all life-threatening emergencies contact 911.
